

The following “pairings” approach, developed by Sue Veith, may assist you in deciding your choices of priority adaptation options from your TWG’s catalog.

1. FLEXIBILITY

(the measure provides future flexibility in the face of SLR and threats)

versus

URGENCY

(the measure is needed soon and/or very timely given current circumstances)

2. BENEFIT

(level of benefit provided)

versus

CAPITAL INTENSITY (OVERALL COSTS)

(Level of cost required)

3. CAPACITY

(the measure increases the capacity in the state to address SLR and threats)

versus

VALUE

(the measure addresses big risks or big needs)
