11. Finalize and report recommendations - TBD

# Development of Straw Proposals for Priority Policy Options

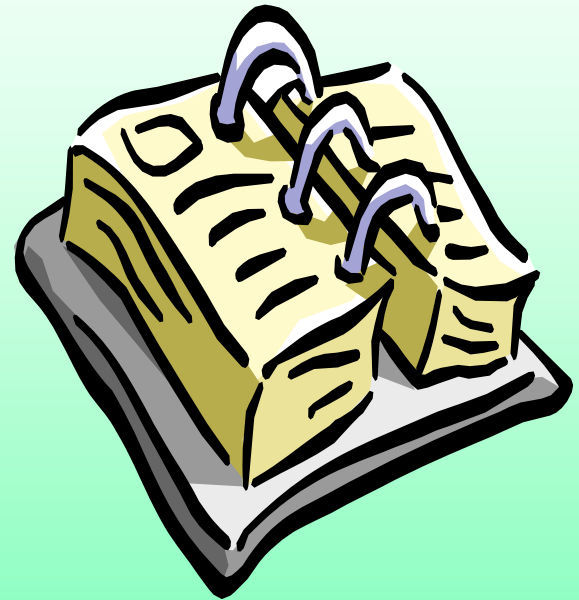
- Policy Option Template:
  - Policy description
  - Policy design
  - Potential implementation mechanisms
  - Related policies/programs in place
  - Type(s) of GHG reductions
  - Estimated GHG savings and cost per MTCO<sub>2e</sub>
  - Key uncertainties
  - Types of additional (non-GHG) benefits and or costs
  - Description of feasibility issues, if needed
  - Status of group approval
  - Level of group support
  - Barriers to consensus

# CC TWG Next Steps

- Develop consensus recommendations on straw proposals on selected priority policy options
  - Small Group Volunteers draft proposals for each policy option
  - Review key issues for discussion on policy description and policy design sections
  - Draft language for potential implementation mechanisms and policies/programs in place
