1. Develop inventory and forecast of emissions - Ongoing
2. Identify a full range of possible actions - Sept. 7-28
3. Identify initial priorities for analysis - Oct 26
4. Develop straw proposals - November
5. Quantify GHG reductions and costs/savings - Dec/**Jan**
6. Evaluate externalities, feasibility issues - Dec/**Jan**
7. Develop implementation mechanisms, alternatives to address barriers - **January**
8. Aggregate results - February
9. Iterate to final agreements - Feb/March
10. Finalize and report recommendations - March

# MD GHG Reduction Goals

- **2015**
  - 10-15% below 2006 levels
- **2020**
  - 25-40% below 2006 levels
- **2050**
  - 90% below 2006 levels
- **2100**
  - 0% or carbon neutral.

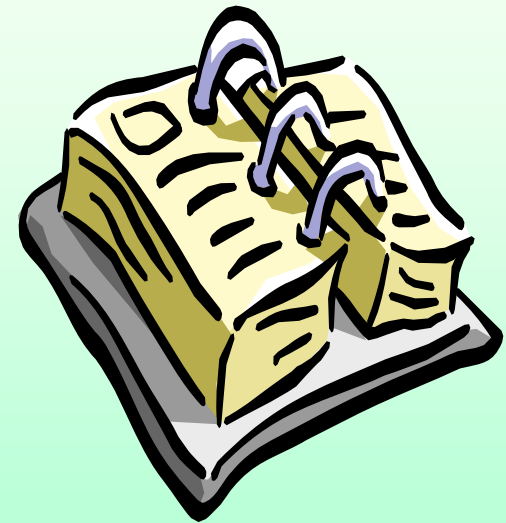
- CCS works on quantifying effects of Proposals
